




## **LEFT TURN OPTIONS**



Cyclist legally, predictably and visibly signals & merges to left turn lane




Cyclist proceeds to far lane (or corner), then proceeds riding straight



Cyclist gets on near corner, dismounts to use crosswalks, then resumes riding


At larger and busier intersections there are a few subtleties to share the road with others:



2 Turn Lanes: Use the right most, Smooth arc: wide enough to clear all turning traffic



Bike Lanes: Merge out to clear Bike Lane for turning traffic; 'Land' in front of the through travel lane, don't block crosswalk



Right Turn Only Lanes: Merge out to clear 'RTOL' for turning traffic; 'Land' in front of the through lane, don't block crosswalk



California's 'Complete Streets' now includes a "2 stage Left-Turn Queue Box" pavement marking and D11-20 sign - Look for them coming soon to a street near you!
